- **WHEREAS**, the proposed amendments would change the salary and/or terms for the President/CEO, General Counsel, and Port Auditor; and
- **WHEREAS**, Staff recommends that the Board adopt a resolution approving amendments to the Employment Agreements for the Executive Director (President/CEO), General Counsel, and Port Auditor.
