Additional effort required for the preparation of the Final EIR, which will include a new project alternative referred to as the Sustainable Terminal Capacity Alternative. Subsequent technical analyses related to air quality, health risk assessment, and greenhouse gas modeling are advised to determine impacts associated with the Sustainable Terminal Capacity Alternative. (\$11,080 for Task 3 Technical Studies + \$12,970 for Task 5 Final EIR + \$5,950 for Task 7 Meetings, Hearings, Project Management, and Quality Control).

 All other terms, covenants, and conditions in the original Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and shall be applicable to this Amendment.
