I am emailing you today on behalf of the homeless community living in their vehicles. For these underprivileged citizens in our community, their vehicles are their homes. Imagine making a home in an RV. It may sound fun to live a nomadic camping lifestyle. That is not what this is. It is limited/no access to a working or sanitary toilet, no shower for weeks, no fridge or stove, no electricity, and having to move multiple times a day to avoid parking citations.

I can understand the community's frustration with these vehicles being visible at the park. But prohibiting them to park in the only place they feel safe is NOT the answer. I am writing to ask you, no beg you, to provide a real solution that provides equity to all members of our community.

Where are these oversized vehicles going to park? You may think " this is not my problem". but it's only a matter of time before it will be because when these large vehicles get impounded due to overdue parking citations in city streets, guess what? All of these citizens will be living on the streets... in tents, under bridges., in the bushes on the sides of freeways. These vehicles can't park in the harbor. Understandable. Please tell us, WHERE CAN THEY PARK?

These community members barely have money to eat and survive, let alone pay for gas for a RV and drive around the city looking for parking OR pay for parking citations. A single parking citation can cost over \$150! This city is targeting and profiting off of the underprivileged community and it's not right. It's wrong, ridiculous and sad.
