ORDINANCE XXXX

ORDINANCE AMENDING THE DISTRICT'S FY 2023 BUDGET, INCREASING THE EQUIPMENT OUTLAY CAPITAL PROJECTS AND OTHER APPROPRIATION BY \$2,723,000 FOR THE ELECTRICAL IMPROVEMENTS PHASE 3 AT THE TENTH AVENUE MARINE TERMINAL PROJECT. ADDITIONAL PROJECT FUNDS WILL BE **BUDGETED IN THE APPROPRIATE FISCAL YEAR** SUBJECT TO BOARD APPROVAL UPON ADOPTION OF EACH FISCAL YEAR'S BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, on April 28, 2022, the San Diego Air Pollution Control District (APCD) announced that the District's application for \$2,723,000 in Community Air Protection Program funds for crane charging infrastructure as part of the Electrical Improvements Phase 3 at Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal (TAMT) Project had been tentatively approved; and

WHEREAS, District and APCD staff have worked collaboratively to finalize the grant agreement so that the Board of Port Commissioners (Board) may accept the grant funds; and

WHEREAS, if approved by the Board, the District would provide a match amount of \$1,167,000; and

WHEREAS, the District's match is fully budgeted in the Economic Recovery Program budget; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the Board adopt an Ordinance amending the District's FY 2023 Budget, increasing the Equipment Outlay and Other Capital Projects appropriation by \$2,723,000 for the Electrical Improvements Phase 3 at Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The FY 2023 Budget is hereby amended to increase the Equipment Outlay and Other Capital Projects appropriation by \$2,723,000 for the Electrical Improvements Phase 3 at Tenth Avenue Marine Terminal Project.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect on the 31st day from its passage by the Board of Port Commissioners.
