RESOLUTION APPROVING THE AUDIT PLAN FOR FY17/18 PURSUANT TO BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS POLICY NO. 035 - POWERS AND FUNCTIONS OF THE PORT AUDITOR

WHEREAS, on June 15, 2017, the draft Audit Plan was submitted to the Committee for review and comment before BPC approval; and

WHEREAS, a summary of the Audit Plan for FY17/18 is attached to the corresponding agenda sheet as Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, the Audit Plan will provide visibility of the overall audit effort and will assist the BPC and District management in achieving the District's strategic goals; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated results of the Audit Plan for FY17/18 will add value in the following areas:

- Assurance that revenues are accurately billed, collected, and reported.
- Safeguarding of assets.
- Efficiency and effectiveness of operations.
- Assurance that internal controls are functioning as intended.
- Assurance that District programs are achieving their intended objectives in an efficient, effective, and equitable manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District that the Audit Plan for Fiscal Year 2017/2018 is hereby approved, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the District Clerk.
