RESOLUTION APPROVING TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE FY2018/19 CAPITAL MAJOR MAINTENANCE CONTINGENCY TO THE STRUCTURAL REPAIRS TO NAVY PIER PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$350,000 PURSUANT TO BPC POLICY NO. 90

- **WHEREAS**, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1; and
- **WHEREAS**, Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) Policy No. 90 establishes a policy for the transfer of amounts between appropriated items in the budget; and
- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to BPC Policy No. 90, a transfer of an amount between appropriated items requires BPC approval; and
- WHEREAS, on June 26, 2018, the District received six (6) bids ranging from \$3,585,140 to \$6,507,800; and
- **WHEREAS**, the low bid exceeds the project budget of \$3,300,000 for the current fiscal year; and
- **WHEREAS**, a transfer request for \$350,000.00 from Major Maintenance Capital contingency to the Structural Repairs to Navy Pier Project in the amount of \$350,000 pursuant to BPC Policy No. 90 will allow for construction costs and a construction contingency; and
- **WHEREAS**, the recommended resolution will approve a transfer of \$350,000 within the FY2018/19 Major Maintenance Capital budget appropriation.
- **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:
- Adopt a resolution approving transfer of \$350,000 from Major Maintenance Capital contingency to the Structural Repairs to Navy Pier Project, pursuant to BPC Policy No. 90.
