## RESOLUTION WAIVING BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (BPC) POLICY 018-A, SECTION 3 TO ALLOW THREE COMMISSIONERS TO SERVE AS FACILITATORS FOR THE MARITIME STAKEHOLDER FORUM DURING 2019

**WHEREAS**, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, (Port Act); and

**WHEREAS**, BPC Policy No. 018-A, Board Stakeholder Forums was adopted on February 12, 2013 in order to provide a venue for the District, Port tenants and other interested persons to discuss and provide input regarding issues being addressed by the Forum pursuant to an annual work-plan approved by the Board of Port Commissioners (Board); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 3 of the Policy states in part, "The Chair [of the Board] may appoint two members of the Board to serve on a Forum as facilitators only"; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2019, the Port of San Diego is fortunate to have three Commissioners who have expressed interest in acting as facilitators of the Maritime Stakeholder Forum; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends waiving BPC Policy No. 018-A section 3 and allowing for three Commissioners to act as facilitators of the Maritime Stakeholder Forum during 2019.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District does hereby waive Board of Port Commissioners Policy No. 018-A, Section 3 to allow three Commissioners to serve as facilitators for the Maritime Stakeholder Forum during 2019.
