## **RESOLUTION 20xx-xxx**

RESOLUTION APPROVING MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE SAN DIEGO UNIFIED PORT DISTRICT AND THE SAN DIEGO HARBOR POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION

**WHEREAS**, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to *Harbors and Navigation Code* Appendix I, (Port Act); and

**WHEREAS**, Section 21 of the Port Act authorizes the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) to pass all necessary ordinances and resolutions for the regulation of the District; and

**WHEREAS**, the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act (MMBA) (*Government Code* Section 3500, et seq.) governs labor-management relations in California local government, including cities, counties, and most special districts; and

**WHEREAS**, the MMBA provides that the governing body of a public agency shall meet and confer in good faith regarding wages, hours, and other terms and conditions of employment with representatives of recognized employee organizations; and

**WHEREAS**, the District met and conferred with the San Diego Harbor Police Officers Association (SDHPOA) with regard to salary, benefits, and other changes and reached a tentative agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, the SDHPOA ratified the proposed tentative agreement on September 3, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the negotiating employees, including the Executive Director and her designees, and General Counsel and his designees, and negotiators for the bargaining group, have declared and disclosed that they had only remote or non-interests (as defined by *Government Code*, Sections 1091 and 1091.5) pertaining to these labor negotiations.

**NOW**, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District, as follows:

The Memorandum of Understanding between the San Diego Unified Port District (District) and the San Diego Harbor Police Officers Association is approved and the Executive Director or her designee is authorized to execute same on behalf of the District.
