**WHEREAS**, minor changes to the policy are recommended for clarification purposes and are provided in a redlined document attached to the corresponding agenda sheet as Attachment A; and

**WHEREAS**, the current policy with suggested revisions has been reviewed by the Audit Oversight Committee.
