# Recitals:

District and Service Provider are parties to an Agreement for Chula Vista Bayfront SWPPP Services. The Agreement is on file in the Office of the District Clerk as Document No. 70602 dated November 6, 2019, as amended by Amendment No. 1, Document No. 70989 dated March 4, 2020, as amended by Amendment No. 2, Document No. 71201 dated May 28, 2020, as amended by Amendment No. 3, Document No. 71951 dated November 4, 2020. It is now proposed to increase the Agreement amount by \$220,000.00 and to amend Attachment B, Compensation & Invoicing.

# The Parties Agree:

- 1. Section 3.a. <u>Maximum Expenditure</u>, is hereby amended to increase the Agreement amount by \$220,000.00 from a total of \$759,922.80 to a new not to exceed total amount of \$979,922.80. The maximum expenditure of the Initial Term shall not exceed \$183,269.00 and the maximum expenditure of the 32-month Optional Term shall not exceed \$796,653.80.
