RESOLUTION APPROVING A FY 2022 BUDGET TRANSFER OF \$385,800 FROM PERSONNEL EXPENSE APPROPRIATION TO THE NON-PERSONNEL EXPENSE APPROPRIATION TO FUND THE BALANCE OF THE BUDGET AMENDMENTS TO MAINTAIN THE CURRENT BUDGETED DEFICIT PURSUANT TO BPC POLICY NO. 90

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Port District (District) is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1962 pursuant to Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix I (Port Act); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) Policy No. 90, a budget transfer of an amount between appropriated items requires BPC approval; and

WHEREAS, staff is recommending the Fiscal Year (FY) 2022 Non-Personnel Expense Appropriation be increased by \$385,000 to fund the balance of the budget amendments to maintain the current budget deficit; and

WHEREAS, the recommended increase of \$385,000 to Non-Personnel Expense Appropriation will be funded by transferring \$385,000 from Personnel Expense Appropriation; and

WHEREAS, approval of this resolution transferring \$385,000 from Personnel Expense Appropriation to Non-Personnel-Expense Appropriation will not impact the deficit, yet it will provide the funding for services the District has determined are needed at this time.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, **BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) of the San Diego Unified Port District hereby authorizes a FY 2022 budget transfer of \$385,000 from Personnel Expense appropriation to the Non-Personnel Expense Appropriation to fund the balance of the budget amendments to maintain the current budgeted deficit pursuant to BPC Policy No. 90.
