## **RESOLUTION 20xx-xxx**

RESOLUTION PROCLAIMING SUPPORT FOR CALIFORNIA CLEAN AIR DAY, A PROJECT OF THE COALITION FOR CLEAN AIR, ON OCTOBER 6, 2021

- **WHEREAS**, the District was created by the California Legislature in 1962 pursuant to the Harbors and Navigation Code Appendix 1, § 1 et seq. ("Port Act"); and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 35 of the Port Act allows the Board of Port Commissioners (BPC) to do all acts necessary and convenient for the exercise of its powers; and
- **WHEREAS**, Section 21 of the Port Act allows the BPC to pass all necessary resolutions for the regulation of the District; and
- **WHEREAS**, the Coalition for Clean Air, a statewide organization founded in 1971, has a mission to protect public health, improve air quality, and prevent climate change; and
- **WHEREAS**, air pollution contributes to cancer and heart and lung diseases which adversely affect individual and public heath; and
- **WHEREAS**, education about air quality can raise community awareness, encourage our community to develop better habits, and improve our community health; and
- **WHEREAS**, California Clean Air Day, which takes place this year on October 6, 2021, is intended to promote actions by individuals, businesses, government agencies, and non-profit organizations throughout California that reduce emissions of pollutants and implement practices to improve air quality; and
- **WHEREAS**, the District has taken actions to reduce emissions through, for example, implementation of its Climate Action Plan (which has already reduced greenhouse gas emissions by 18% since 2006), providing reimbursement for employees who purchase public transit passes, and constructing shore-power infrastructure; and
- **WHEREAS**, California Clean Air Day aligns with the District's development of a Maritime Clean Air Strategy (MCAS) with an overarching vision of "Health Equity for All"; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff recommends that the Board adopt a resolution proclaiming support for California Clean Air Day; and

**WHEREAS**, District staff recommends that the Board authorize the District's Executive Officer or his duly authorized representative to complete the clean air pledge.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Port Commissioners of the San Diego Unified Port District hereby proclaims support for California Clean Air Day.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Executive Director or his designated representative is hereby authorized on behalf of the San Diego Unified Port District to sign the Clean Air Pledge.
