- Item No. 0600— Merchandise N.O.S.
- Item No. 0647— Cruise Ships
 - (a) Passengers, embarking or disembarking to or from passenger vessels, through Port of San Diego facilities, or passengers in-transit on passenger vessels at Port of San Diego facilities, per passenger

Amended Language

RULES & RATE

- Item No. 0572— Dockage for Transient Vessels
 - (1) Dock space is available for periods of no more than twelve (12) days within a calendar month and no more than twelve (12) consecutive days on a first-come, first-served basis. Minimum leave time: five (5) consecutive days.
 - (2) Vessel owner/operator must provide current evidence of vessel registration and owner/operator identification prior to obtaining dock space.

New Language

MISCELLANEOUS

Item No. 0759— Hazardous Material Surcharge

In the event that, the District receives incidental hazardous material(s) or cargo(es), a surcharge of an additional fifty-percent (50%) will be assessed over the normal applicable Tariff rate(s)
