## **Maritime Clean Air Strategy**

Ocean-going Vessels In-Transit Goal 18 Reduce annual ocean-going vessel in-transit emissions.

Ocean-going Vessels In-Transit Objective 1A: Pursue implementing an expanded Vessel Speed Reduction Program that achieves upwards of 90% participation, subject to further Board of Port Commissioners' approval.

## **Existing v. Updated VSR Program**

#### **Existing Program (Est. 2009)**

#### Rule -

- Target: 80% Vessel Participation
- Cargo: 12 kts max speed 20nm from Point Loma
- Cruise: 15 kts max speed 20nm from Point Loma
- Authority: Voluntary + Coastal Development Permit

#### **Enhanced Program (Pending)**

#### Rule -

- Target: 90% Vessel Participation
- Cargo: 12 kts avg. speed 40nm from Point Loma
- Cruise: 15 kts avg. speed 40nm from Point Loma
- Underwater noise outreach
- Methodology update
- Authority: Voluntary + Coastal Development Permit
